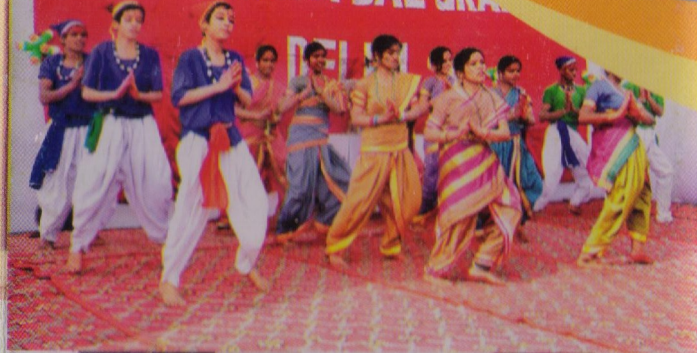

## Founder



**Shri S.L. Minda (1930-2010)**

Shri Shadi Lal Minda was a leading industrialist and a renowned philanthropist. In 1987, he founded the Moga Devi Minda Charitable Trust (MDMCT). Minda Bal Gram - a home for children in need of care and protection was established in 2001 and is managed by MDMCT. MBG is licensed with the Department of Women and Child Development, Government of NCT of Delhi.

## Vision:

Every child deserves a safe and secure childhood so that s/he can develop intellectual, practical and spiritual capacities to lead a meaningful adult life and contribute in nation building.

## Mission:

To provide conditions that help children to develop their full potential in an atmosphere of happiness, love and understanding.

## Aims And Objectives

The following are the aims and objectives of Minda Bal Gram:

- To provide love, care and protection to children in a family like environment;
- To fulfil their basic and other developmental needs;
- To provide education, vocational training and grant scholarships and sponsorships;
- To provide hygienic and healthy living environment;
- To help develop children into respectable and responsible citizens;
- To help, support and facilitate after care facilities, employment and social reintegration;

## Minda Bal Gram

### An expanse of love, care and protection

In 2001, Minda Bal Gram was founded by Shri S. L. Minda. It provides long-term institutional care to the children in need of care and protection under the Juvenile Justice Act (Care and Protection of Children) 2000.

MBG provides support and assistance to its children wishing to pursue academics or other training/skill. Scholarships and sponsorships are awarded for higher education or training by the Moga Devi Minda Charitable Trust, Delhi.

In a span of more than a decade Minda Bal Gram has served hundreds of children. It has restored more than 50% of its children either to their families or rehabilitated them safely into society. Children come to Minda Bal Gram through a statutory body called the Child Welfare Committee (Bench of Magistrates) constituted under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2000.

## Education Facilities

All children are provided education facilities. A number of children attend Degree Courses, Vocational Courses in trades like Computers, Fashion Designing, Cutting and Tailoring, Turner, Fitter and Hotel Management from premier Education & Training Institutes, respectively.

## Residential Facilities

Safe residential facilities are provided by the organisation to all the children. There are different sets of houses that are complete with 2 or 3 rooms, a pantry, play area, sufficient number of wash rooms and toilets.

There are five residential blocks for boys and girls:

- Sanskar Sadan: Home for pre-primary children
- Shraddha Sadan: Home for upper primary girls
- Sankalp Sadan: Home for upper primary boys
- Pratibha Sadan: Home for teenage girls
- PratiGYa Sadan: Home for teenage boys

## Library Facilities

There is a well stocked library to capture the interests of children. There are about 3000 books, reference books, periodicals and newsletters with availability of daily national English and Hindi Newspaper and Current Affairs Magazines. Children have easy access to the library.

## Life Skills Facilities

Children are provided with life skills in a planned manner. Children are provided skills in gardening and handling of simple tools, plantation and harvesting, housekeeping, handling consumable and non consumable stocks and cooking food. Children also take part in co-curricular activities that include music both vocal and instrumental, dramatics, painting, clay modelling etc.

## Sports and Games

Children participate in several games like football, cricket, hockey, badminton and a number of athletic events. A number of children have secured top positions in sports and games in competitions held at school, district, zone and state levels. In Hockey, at least three children from MBG have represented the State at National level in the under-16 and under-19 years categories.

## Recreation

The children have the opportunity to watch Television, its entertainment shows, cartoons, current affairs and news. There are recreation halls for boys and girls. An event is organised on the last day of each month and all the children party and celebrate the birthdays of children in the month. All the staff members and children join the party and have a good time.

## Medical Facilities

There is a medical room where a qualified MBBS doctor is available to tackle any medical ailment or emergency. Medical emergencies of the children are referred to a nearby hospital/nursing home for immediate succour.
